CLASS LEVELS & FAMILY PROGRAM

ADULT/STAFF/INTERPRETERS/EDUCATORS CLASS:

Level 1: No previous ASL knowledge required.

Level 2: Requires some prior sign instruction or interaction with people who are Deaf.

Level 3: Possess basic conversational skills, seeking increased vocabulary and syntax.

Level 4: Strong conversational skills, seeking increased vocabulary and fluency.

Level 5: Seeking to build on existing communication fluency.

Level 6: Tailored class for those who have mastered Level 5. Application of your skills, including comprehension practice.

FAMILY PROGRAM:

Levels will be tailored to the family members ASL level and ages of all children who are participating: (Beginners, Intermediate or Advanced).

- ♦ **Some classes may be cancelled or combined if registration numbers are too low.**
- ♦ **Staff will informally assess student levels and re-assign if needed.**
